Jumeirah Beach Resorts and Hotels

Jumeirah Beach Hotel This five star hotel was established in the year 1997. Opposite to this hotel, in the sea, stands the sail-shaped Burj Al Arab. The hotel is constructed in the shape of a wave to compliment the Burj Al Arab. The hotel is the Wild Wadi Water Park and a major landmark of Dubai. Initially it was the ninth tallest building in Dubai but today, it is ranked lower than the 100th tallest building. In spite of this, it remains a popular tourist destination.

Mina A' Salam It was the first Dubai beach hotel. It seems to exhibit a fusion of Dubai's modern-day opulence with its old-world architecture. There are 292 rooms, constructed in such a way that each faces the scenic beauty of the sea. All of them are styled according to the Arabian theme: heavy studded doors, Moorish arches hung with ornate lanterns and high beds with exotic dark blue, red and gold fabrics. But the large terraces are the most attractive features of this hotel. It has a village outlook but the difference is that it's a luxurious village!

Le Royal Meridien It is located on a pristine stretch of private beach. From this hotel, you get a stunning view of the Arabian Gulf. It is set in landscaped gardens overlooking the famous Jumeirah beach. It is one of the most romantic hotels. It looks like a storehouse of roses. In each room of this hotel, you will find finger bowls of water floating with petals to dip the digits. The bathroom has more blooms than even a florist. Rose residues are also scattered on the bed. So, if you are looking for a romantic holiday, then head forward to this resort.

Le Meridien Mina Seyahi It is a boutique-styled luxury beach resort set on Jumeirah Beach. It stands opposite to Emirates Golf Club and Montgomery Golf Course. It will be more appropriate for a bit adventurous tourists as it features outdoor facilities for up to 5,000 guests. The sports activities that it provides include water skiing, kayaking, and windsurfing.

Some of Dubai's cultural and tourist venues like the Dubai Museum and Gold and Spice Souks are conveniently accessible from the hotel.

Burj Al Arab It is a giant sized beach resort, the tallest amongst all with a height of 321 metres. It is situated on an artificial island and is connected to the mainland by a private curving bridge. It is the world's first seven star hotel. It contains more than 20,000 square feet of real gold leaf.
